

BETTER CONTROL

- **Records Management from the Archive** - helps organizations to use Enterprise Vault as part of their records management process. This is especially relevant for U. S. Federal government regulations (Capstone)
- **Classification** - builds on the existing classification feature with further performance and rule enhancements. Classify content from any source as it's ingested into the archive
- **Retention Plans** - offer more flexibility to manage retention control across journal locations with UI & PowerShell improvements

IMPROVED MANAGABILITY

- **File System Folder Shortcuts** - Jump straight to the folder location in Enterprise Vault Search for quick & easy user access without relying on placeholders
- **IMAP Deployment** - simplification of IMAP profiles enables users now to just use their user name to access their archive via IMAP
- **Archive Permission Auditing** - track manual permission changes to satisfy security audit requirements
- **SQL 2016 & SharePoint 2016** - support for the latest Microsoft releases
- **PowerShell** - builds on our continued commitment to PowerShell enable all administrator tasks. Completely automates File System Archiving (FSA) configuration, export archives and list ALL archives
- **Update Service Location** - enhanced now with Role Based Administration (RBA) and doesn't require a password if the services already exist

ENHANCED SUPERVISION AND SEARCH

- **Additional Accelerator Reporting** - provides the ability to create an "end-to-end" archive report for Enterprise Vault and the Accelerators (Discovery Accelerator, Compliance Accelerator), tracking message progress from receipt, storage, and indexing all the way through the search/sampling process
- **Audit Preview Activity** - introduces audit & track preview actions in the Accelerator clients to show if reviewer has looked at an item
- **Enterprise Vault Search** - a UX refresh improves accessibility and speed of search. New Enterprise Vault Search policy helps make it easier for users to search against tags and index properties
- **OWA Support** - users now can double-click to open archived email from within OWA 2010, 2013 & 2016.
